## INTRODUCTION

- 1 How can we be certain of God's justice? How is God sovereign over all of the corruption in the world? Why is the idea of judgment so difficult to understand?
- 2 How does sin distort our ability to walk in the ways of the Lord? How does the Spirit guide us?
- 3 Why is our faithfulness to Christ important in fighting against the injustice in the world? In what ways are you being a beacon of hope to the needy and poor and spirit?
- 4 Positions of power and authority are valuable to our society and the kingdom of God? How are they rightly leveraged to speak the word of God? Why must we constantly pray for the leaders of the world and the church?
- 5 What is a godly response to unjust leadership? Why is apathy towards injustice just as harmful as acts of oppression?
- 6 As you read Micah 4:1-5, describe the beauty and majesty of God's grace. What is the message of peace to the world? Why is it important to consistently celebrate these promises from God?
- 7 In what ways is Jesus the perfect prophet, priest, and king? How does Jesus provide the way for us to walk in righteousness and justice?

Spend time in prayer thanking God for sending Jesus to satisfy the wrath of God and rescue his people from deserved judgement. Pray for opportunities to bring the gospel message of hope, joy and peace this Christmas season.
