Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

Drew challenged our church on Sunday to take the lives of children seriously. Some of the topics that he discussed are difficult and divisive. As you engage in conversation, be kind and mindful of one another. Our first task in this journey is to love one another as Christ has loved us.

DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

1. Do you think that child worship is prevalent in our society? In the church? In what ways have you seen this demonstrated?
2. Read Psalm 127:3-5. How can we be more actively and worshipfully involved in our children’s lives? Where does a child’s value come from? How can we actively embrace them as a blessing without making them the center of our world?
3. Read Luke 1:26-33. Jesus was fully man and experienced full human life, even as a fetus. How has the church been unloving while being adamantly pro-life? What are some ways in which we can better love and engage those who find themselves contemplating abortion?
4. Read Psalm 139:13-16. What does it mean that we are ‘fearfully and wonderfully made?’ Why is difficult to value things that are not seen?
5. In what ways does adoption demonstrate the Gospel? Why is adoption difficult for so many people to consider or embrace? What can we, as a church, do to better demonstrate this to the world?
