



# 1 Corinthians 1:10-2:5 “The Church: Team Jesus”

## Discussion Questions

### INTRODUCTION

The purpose of Paul’s letter to the Church at Corinth was to address the divisions and rivalries that had risen. There were factions that called themselves followers of Apollos and Peter and Paul, but none of these divisions is Biblical. Paul calls the church to recenter its identity not on a leader, but on Christ’s work for the the people.

### DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

1. Unity is something for which we must fight. In what areas of your Christian life do you have to fight for unity? What circumstances oppose that unity that you should have with Christ and other believers?
2. Many people see unity as uniformity. How is unity about harmony (embracing our differences) rather than erasing our differences in opinion or culture?
3. What is relational unity? Why might relational unity be difficult? What obstacles do you see for relational unity within Harvest Church?
4. Steve Brown says this about Christian leaders: “When we worship at the altar of another human being, we chain ourselves to false expectations about our idol and about ourselves.” What is he saying about the leaders of the church? How should we be unified in light of this truth?
5. Christians are most unified when they participate in the mission of the Kingdom of God. What is your role in the mission of God? How can you live that out this week? In what areas do you need encouragement or guidance?

Spend some time in prayer with one another for things drawn out of the discussion.
