Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

Paul is completely concerned with the Gospel. It is primary and first for the life of a Christian. Many Christians think of the Gospel as merely about love or merely the entry point into Christianity, but it is the focal point of Christian obedience, ethics, missions, and living.

DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

Gospel content

How do you view the wrath of God? Why is it so difficult to think about God's wrath? Why is God's love emptied if we take away His righteous wrath?

Gospel Confirmation

How different you might live if you had a stronger awareness that Christ is alive and reigning? Have you ever thought about how the OT points to Christ? Why is it so necessary to view all scriptures as pointing to Christ?

Gospel Centrality

What is difficult about making the gospel central in everything? Why is the gospel so central to Paul? Why is the gospel not just something we believe once and then move on? Why is the gospel central to our growth in Christ and growth in holiness?

Gospel Effects

What is your gospel sweat? How does the gospel produce gospel sweat? What could you do to sweat more for the Gospel? Why is it better to sweat for the gospel in community, how might your community sweat together?

Why is it so hard sometimes to be defined by Christ rather than Sin? What struggles tempt to define you? Share your testimony of receiving a new heart.
